

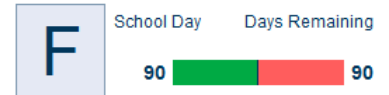

Sriharshita “Harshu” Musunuri is a junior inventor, researcher, scientist and emerging polymath. Her TEDx talk advocates the pursuit of multiple disciplines to facilitate knowledge and to achieve contemporary renaissance. Harshu conducts research in thermoelectrics and has earned national recognition for her studies and invention. She was an intern at the NASA Jet Propulsion Laboratory and is curriculum director of the non-profit Girls Rock in Science and Math. She is a 2016 Davidson Fellow Laureate, junior at Henry M. Jackson High School in Mill Creek, and student researcher in a University of Washington chemical engineering lab.
