- All three Jackson Jazz Bands performed to a packed house at **Jazz Alley** in Seattle. It was great fun and a marvelous "authentic professional musician" experience for the kids.
- Five of our jazz band members formed a jazz quintet and played for the School Board meeting.
- Our Honors Wind Ensemble, Wind Ensemble, Symphonic Band, and Concert Band performed at Band Festival, where their performances were judged and rated by three adjudicators using a rubric of National Music Education Standards. Honors Wind Ensemble, Wind Ensemble, and Symphonic Bands all earned SUPERIOR ratings (the top rating of five levels). Honors Wind Ensemble was rated at the highest level on the scoring rubric, and they performed college-level literature.
