



Elementary Summer Experience 2017 Parent Information

Can my child attend?

- Students currently in kindergarten, 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th grades who are not yet at standard are invited to attend based on specific criteria by grade level.
- Students who are English learners are invited to attend based on their ELPA scores.
- Teachers will invite students who are eligible based on their reading, math, and/or ELPA scores.

When and Where?

- Mondays through Thursdays, July 10 — August 10. There is no class on Fridays.
- Classes will be held at six schools.

What does it cost?

- Elementary Summer Experience is free, paid through state and federal grants funding.

What about meals and transportation?

- Free breakfast and lunch are included for all students.
- Transportation will be provided from several pick up sites.

What will my child do each day?

Elementary Summer Experience will provide your child with instruction in reading, writing, math, and science. The daily schedule includes 60 minutes of science, 60 minutes of reading and writing in small groups, and 60 minutes of math. Students will participate in a variety of engaging and fun activities that will build their vocabulary and improve their skills. Math content will focus on number sense, place value, and operations and algebraic thinking. There will be two on-site experiences for enrichment. Students will have access to the school library for weekly book checkout to encourage participation in the Summer Reading Challenge.

The class will have approximately 15 students with one teacher and para-educator support.

Why should my child attend?

Your child will receive 70 hours of small group, focused instruction in key skills for success in the coming year. Your child will have fun learning and exploring!

How do I register? When are registration forms due?

- Complete the registration form from your child's teacher.
- Registration forms must be turned in by May 1, 2017 to reserve space. Turn in the form to the teacher.
