For many of our athletes, this will be their first time Wrestling. One big difference between wrestling and any other sports is playing time. All wrestlers get playing time. With wrestling, everybody is scheduled to go three rounds in a match. Another big difference is that in wrestling players are sorted by size (weight); middle school wrestling has a minimum of 17 weight classes. An athlete may only wrestle up one weight class, he may not wrestle down. Middle school wrestlers must be over 64# and under 285# (smaller weight classes are 5# apart). For many of the smaller athletes, this will be the first time they will get to play against athletes their own size.
