Graduation: Saturday, June 18, 2016 Xfinity Arena, 4:00 p.m. Graduates should arrive at 3:00 p.m. Doors open for guests at 3:15 p.m.

<u>Caps & Gowns:</u> All graduates will wear official school caps and gowns during the commencement ceremony. Josten's is the designated supplier for these items. <u>Clearance Forms:</u> Seniors will be issued Clearance Forms on June 8. Senior students without EHS classes must pick up this form from the Treasurer's Office. Clearance Forms must be properly signed and returned to the Treasurer's Office <u>before or after school or during lunch only</u> by **10:00 a.m.** on **June 15**.

<u>Commencement Rehearsals:</u> Rehearsals will be on June 16 and 17 in the morning. <u>It is mandatory ALL seniors participate in both rehearsals.</u>

<u>Commencement Tickets:</u> Each Senior will receive ten commencement tickets. These will be

distributed during rehearsal on June 17 to students who have turned in their completed Clearance Forms. Request forms for additional tickets are now available in the Main Office and must be returned by June 3. Extra tickets will be included with tickets distributed at rehearsal on June 17.

<u>Coursework:</u> <u>ALL</u> coursework, including CE work must be at standard no later than noon on Wednesday, June 15 to be eligible to walk across the stage on June 18.

Diploma: Your diploma and Certificate of Immunization Status will be available to be picked up in the Main Office beginning June 23. Please note the office will remain open 7:00 a.m.-3:00 p.m. M-F until June 29. In July it will be open only on Wednesdays from 9:00 a.m.-12:00 p.m.

<u>Final Transcripts:</u> If you have requested transcripts at any time throughout the year using Naviance, your final transcripts will automatically be sent after 2nd semester grades have been posted.

<u>Library Books:</u> All library books are due prior to June 10.

Running Start Students: You will be receiving a Running Start Grade Check form in the mail. The form must be completed and signed by your Running Start instructor(s) and returned to your Counselor by June 8 at 2:00 p.m. if you plan on participating in the Graduation Ceremony.

Senior Ball: The Senior Ball will be held on June 11th at the Bell Harbor Club in Seattle. Doors open at 7:00 p.m. and dinner will be promptly served at 7:30. Pictures will be taken at the dance prior to dinner and immediately following dinner. Dance tickets are being sold May 23rd through June 3. Tickets are \$70 each including dinner. If you purchase tickets after 2:15 p.m. on June 3, you still may attend the dance, however there will be no meal included. Guest forms are due to Ms. Kippenhan by May 27.

<u>Senior Lunch:</u> Senior Lunch will be held on June 17 following the Commencement Rehearsal. The Senior Class officers plan this event. Tickets will be available in June and can be purchased at the Treasurer's Office.
