The SBA is replacing the Reading, Writing and Math assessments formally known as the **Measurements of Student Progress** (MSP) testing for all students' grades 3-5.

ECEAP preschool accepting applications for 2015-2016.


Everett Public Schools Early Childhood Education & Assistance Program (ECEAP) is a FREE preschool program for income-eligible families with children four years of age.

Please turn in: Registration packet, student immunization records, proof of residency, and student birth certificate.

Please help your student to remember that stuffed animals and toys are <u>not</u> allowed at school.
