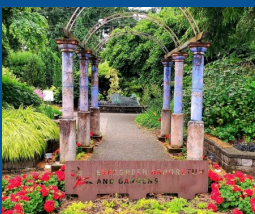


Free Concert series: July 16, 30 and 13 at noon at Comeford Park, 501 Delta Ave.
