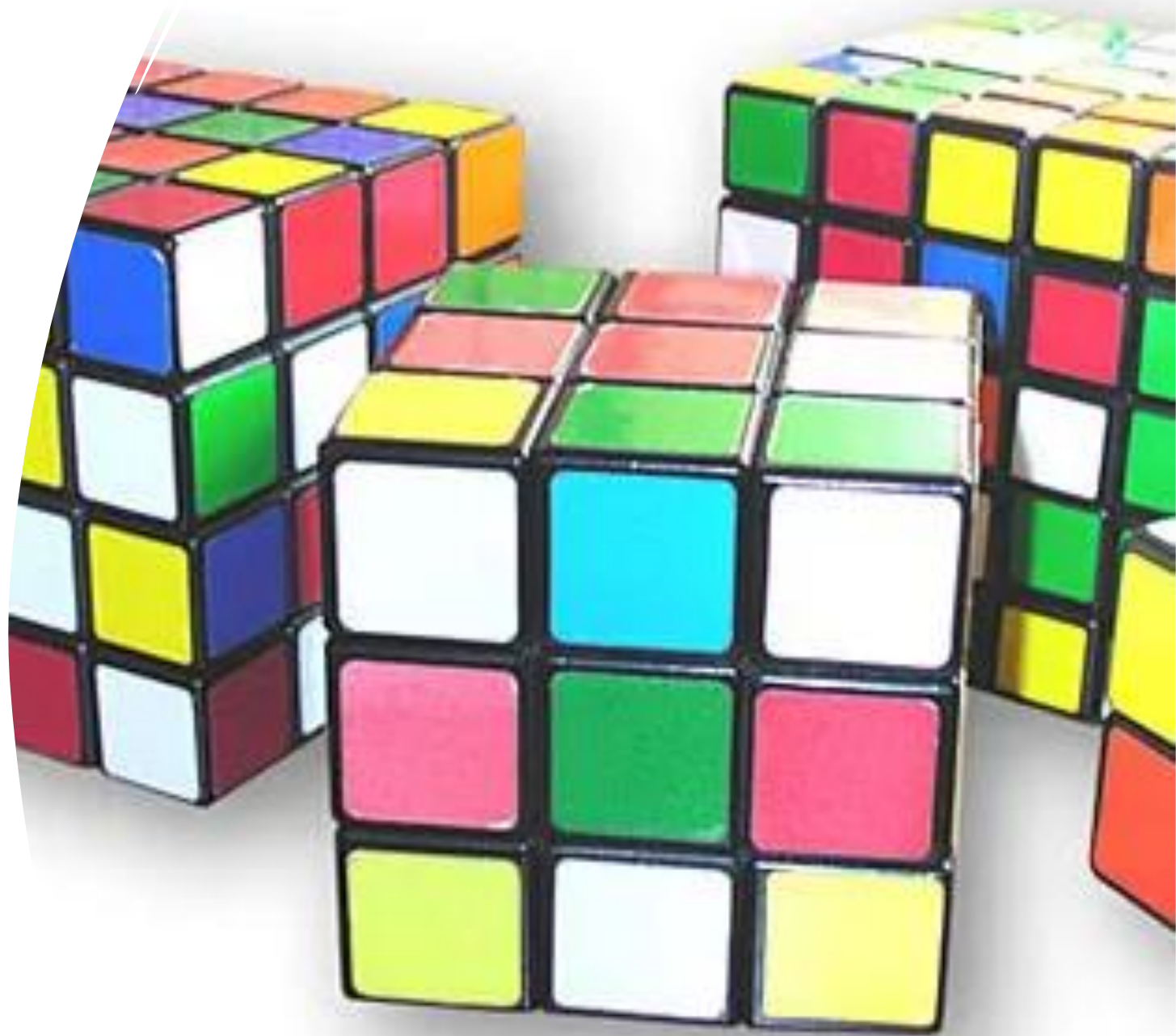

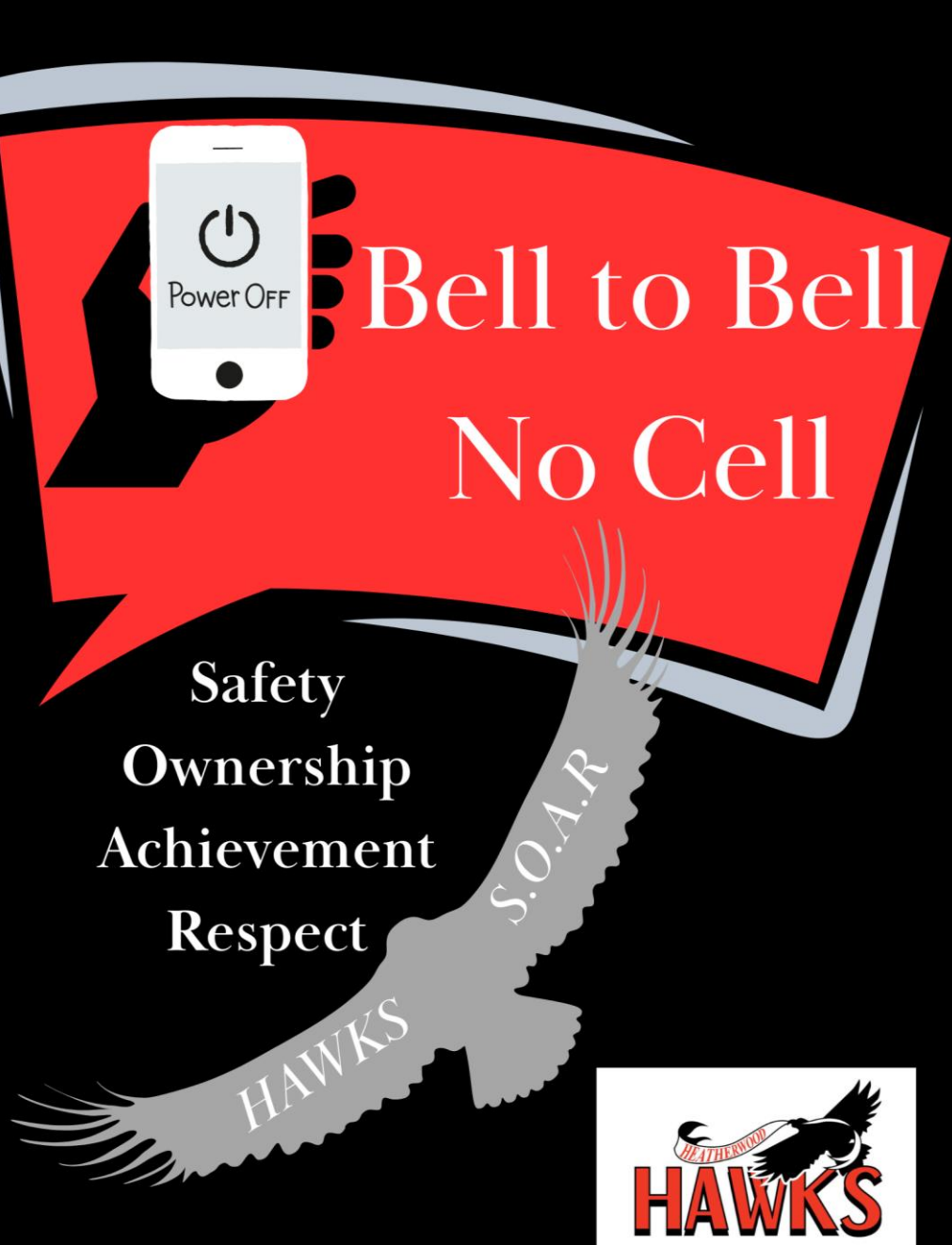


VETERANS DAY ASSEMBLY
