


Lost & Found

Earthquake Drill Reminders Heatherwood Middle School

Earthquake Drill Overview

- There will be an announcement that we are in an earthquake drill.
- All Students:
 - Stop what you are doing and stay calm.
 - If you are inside, stay inside: Take cover immediately under a table, desk, or counter.
 - If you are outside, stay outside: Go to an open area away from hazards.
 - Remain quiet and in a safe position, until shaking has stopped or until staff gives a direction that the earthquake drill has ended.

Imagine the earth starts moving –IT'S AN EARTHQUAKE!

Time to drop, cover, and hold on!

EVERYONE DROP!!! COVER!!! HOLD ON!!!




