Lockdown Drill Reminders Heatherwood Middle School

Lockdown Drill Overview


- An announcement will be made that the school is in a lockdown. If this is a practice drill, this will be in the announcement.
- All students:
 - Stop what you are doing and listen for staff directions.
 - Students in a classroom stay in their classroom. Students in the hallways will find the closest classroom immediately and follow staff directions to lockdown.
 - Ouring a full lockdown drill, we close and lock all doors and windows, turn off lights, sit silently, and wait for further instructions.
- There will be an additional announcement once the drill is completed.

Lockdown Drill Safety Reminders

- Find closest classroom/room that can be secured and locked.
- Find best location within classroom that is not visible from the hallway.
- During Lockdown:
 - Sit Silently
 - Follow staff directions
