- Articles can be Word documents or typed directly into the body of an email. To the extent possible, please avoid using fancy fonts and formatting and embedded images. Plain text is easiest to input into our newsletter format.
- Keep in mind that most people skim the *Wolf Tracks* and will not read a lot of copy. Keep articles brief with links to more detailed information you might have, and consider using bullet points.
- We will edit longer articles to increase readability.
- Flyers should be kept at a half page or less.
- Please send images as separate attachments, not embedded in your articles; .jpg files are best.
- When submitting photos of students, you must include their first and last names so we can verify whether or not we have permission to publish their photos.
- When submitting a form or an ad, we prefer a Word or a Publisher document or a .jpg file, if possible. PDF files have to be converted to .jpg before we can insert them in the newsletter.
