

- I. Intro/Thesis Rubric Point(s): A1
- II. Historical Context Rubric Point(s): B1
  - Set the Stage for the theme of the prompt
  - \* Can combine HC and Thesis into a single paragraph (always finish with the Thesis)
- III. Body Paragraph #1
  - a. Topic Sentence (aka Mini-Thesis)
    - select 1 analytical category/line of reasoning from your thesis statement
  - b. Introduce your 1st document Rubric Point(s): C1
    - Quote, paraphrase, summarize
    - Cite (Doc #)
  - c. Clearly explain how the doc supports your argument Rubric Point(s): C2
  - d. SIPP-Y to document Rubric Point(s): D1
    - Be sure to explain how the SIPP is relevant
  - e. Introduce Evidence Beyond the Document (EBD) Rubric Point(s): C3
    - Be sure to explain how it supports your argument
  - f. Repeat steps III.b-c for a 2nd document (If needed)
- IV. Body Paragraph #2
  - Repeat steps a-f
- V. Body Paragraph #3
  - Repeat steps a-f
- VI. Conclusion (if time is available)
  - Restate your argument
