

SMARTER BALANCED ASSESSMENT (SBA)

Smarter Balanced Assessment (SBA) in English Language Arts are administered to students in grade 3-8, 10 and 11. Students who pass the SBA in grade 10 at the College and Career Readiness standard are not required to repeat the exam in grade 11. SBA in math are administered in grades 3-8 and 11. Students in the classes of 2019 and beyond are required to pass the high school SBA in math at the graduation requirement level. Students who score a level 3 or 4 on the high school SBA qualify for placement in a college level English and math courses at Washington public two and four year post secondary institutions.
