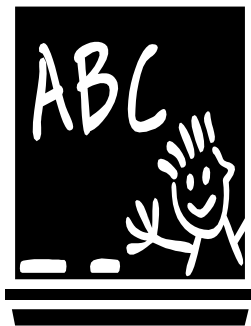
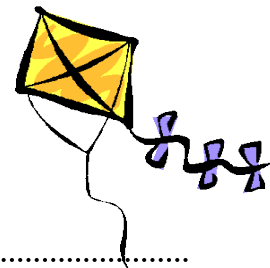

## Monthly 2nd Grade Newsletter

### This Month in 2nd grade:

**Reading:** Students this month will be learning to reread text in order to examine text more closely. This is referred to as “close” reading. We just finished our Reach for Reading Unit “Why is nature always changing?” We are beginning a new Reach for Reading unit with the big question, “Why do people work together?” When reading stories, students are learning to determine which information in a text is most important by reading it carefully. This is a valuable comprehension skill.



This week, students will finish their study of geometry/fractions and then will jump into three digit addition and subtraction with regrouping. They will use regrouping (trading) when subtracting 3-digit numbers. We will also work on further enhancing our understanding of the relationship between addition and subtraction. We will practice using logical thinking, using number charts, number lines, blocks and drawing pictures to solve story problems. Students will continue to have math homework a couple of times per week.
