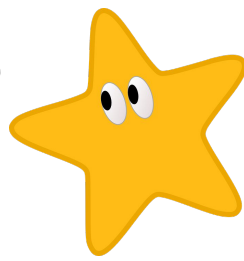

Summer Literacy & Mathematics

As we come to a close of the school year I would like to encourage each family to make a summer plan that includes writing 2X weekly (I will give your child a journal-Everyone who brings it back finished to me in the fall earns a prize!). Another idea - encourage your child to write letters. I love reading about summer adventures, send an email to jtoneri@everettsd.org and I promise to respond! Ask your child to read daily/4X weekly for at least 30 minutes. Setting up a special time to do this, often, supports reading success. Mathematics, make sure your child knows his/her facts 0-20 (+ -) from memory, then start memorizing multiplication facts. Make story problems out of everyday activities. For example, "If we leave at 2:00 p.m. and drive to the beach and arrive at 2:30 p.m., How long did it take us to get there?"

Keep Your Skills Sharp!
