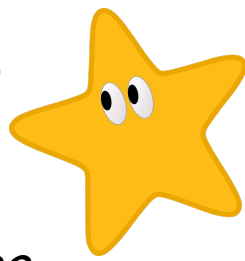

Mathematics

This week, students have been learning to "decompose" numbers, essentially separating 10s and 1s when adding and subtracting and using base 10 blocks to trade 10 ones for a ten to make it easier to subtract and ten ones for a ten to make it easier to add. We also started learning how to solve a multiple step mathematical problem. You should find examples of your child's work in your child's daily take home folder.
