Copied Information Below from Our Superintendent's Letter Sent to All Parents:

**Computer Use at Home:** In order to better engage in learning while at home, it is vital for students to have a computer and internet access. All high school students and most middle school students already have a 1:1 device, thanks to the 2016 Technology Levy. If any student does not have access to a computer at home, Wednesday, March 18<sup>th</sup> or Monday, March 23<sup>rd</sup>, they can pick up a device from Everett Public Schools to use at home while the school closure is in effect. You can pick up a device at two locations:

March 18<sup>th</sup>, 2020 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.

- Community Resource Center 3900 Broadway, Everett, WA
- Jackson High School 1508 136<sup>th</sup> St. SE, Mill Creek WA

Parents/guardians will need to provide their students(s) ID number and sign a Usage Agreement Form, which they can do beforehand online, or as a hard copy when they pick up the device. Internet Hotspots will also be available to check out for those who do not have internet access at home. Support and information about Wi-Fi hotspots are also available on the technology webpage.
