Grammar Rules Past-Tense Verbs

- Add *-ed* to most verbs when you talk about a past action.
Example: *kick + -ed = kicked*
- Some verbs have special forms to show an action in the past. Example: *say → said*

1. Gecko want/wanted to sleep that night.
2. Gecko goed/went to see Elephant.
3. Elephant talks/talked to the fireflies last week.
4. The fireflies seed/saw Elephant coming.
