The Auditorium Technician and Custodian will be on duty for the entire use time.

All users will supply the loading/running crew, box office, and ushers for all events.

Frequently Asked Questions:

Will there be a crew on site to run my show?

No, the rental comes with a Technician and a Custodian. The Auditorium Technician will be available to operate one of the elements of the show (sound, lights, fly, deckhand), but you need to provide the balance of the crew for the load in, run, and load out.

Where can I have concessions?

The South Foyer from the seating area is where we can accommodate two 12' tables for concessions. Food and drink items must be consumed in the same South Foyer area. The producer is responsible for not allowing food or drink in the Auditorium.

Lobby Displays

There is space for a maximum of four 8' tables in the Auditorium lobby. These can be used for displays of promotional materials and ticket sales and Will Call for your event. Non Food or Drink items (flowers, CDs, merchandise) are allowed. The house takes 0% cut from all sales in-house.

Flying Scenery

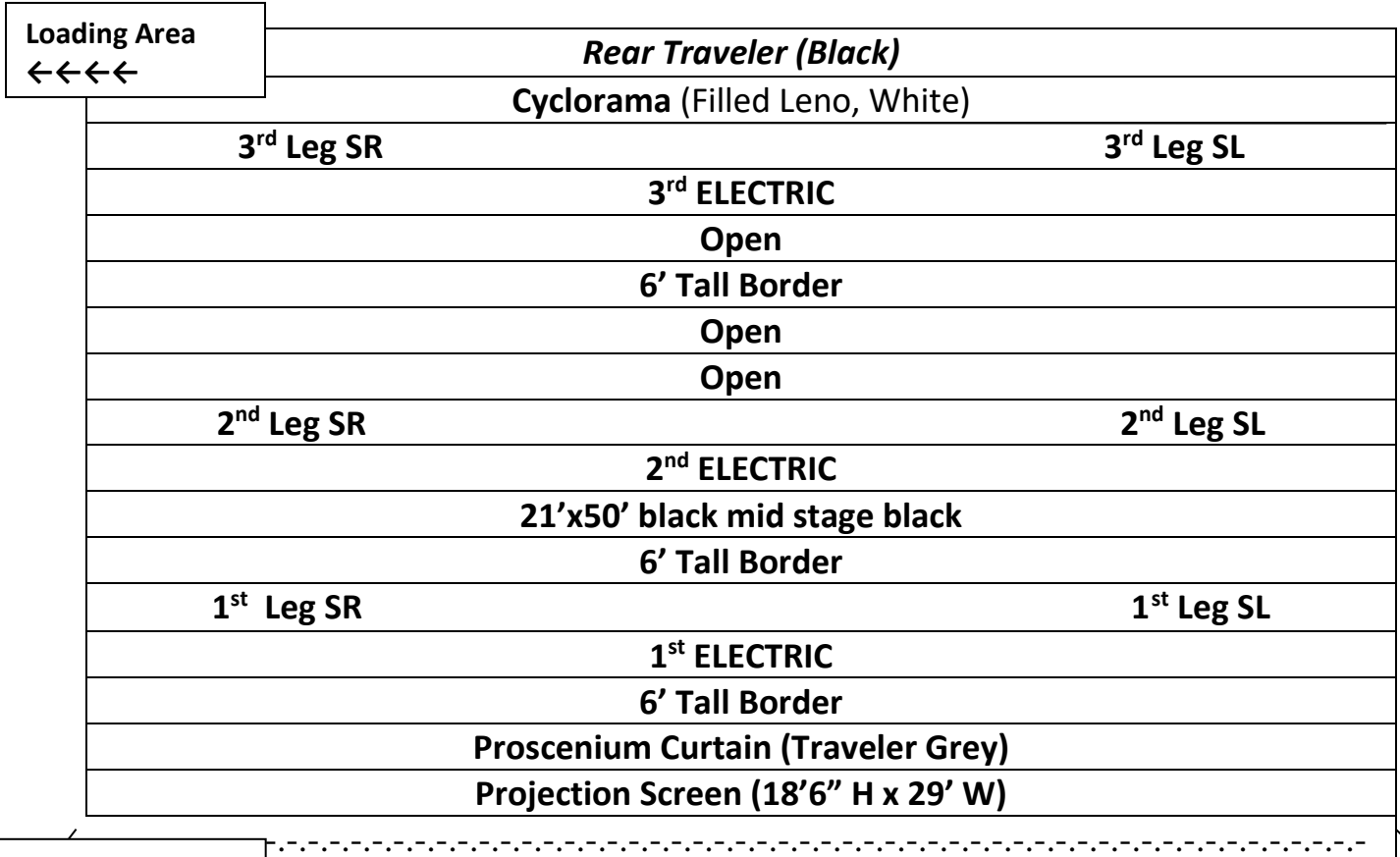
This Auditorium is a Hemp and Bag House. Flymen and Weight loaders must be 18 years and older. There is a limited number of battens to use. The maximum weight on any one batten is 150 lbs. Each batten is made of 1½" pipe on nylon rope.

Audio

Our system is designed for basic PA operations. We have limited house equipment. More complicated setups can be contracted out through outside contractors. A list of recommended vendors is available.

Stage Layout and Fly

Legs have split Battens; all other Battens are 50'



1st Apron Lighting

- Proscenium opening 50' wide by 20'tall
- Apron depth 28' / Apron width 69'
- Proscenium to rear traveler 28'
- Electric height is 20' for Apron 1 and 2
- Fly height is 42'
- 3' crossover behind rear Traveler
- The acoustic cloud above the apron prevents hanging from 2nd apron to plaster line
