
# **Emotional Cycle of Deployment**



## 7 Core Functions of the SLO

- 2. Deployment Support
- 3. Special Education System Navigation
- 4. Command, School, Community Communications
- 5. Home School Linkage and Support
- 6. Partnerships in Education
- 7. Post-Secondary Preparation

Eligibility for School Liaison Officer Services: SLOs serve families of active duty, guard, reservists and civilian employees of all military branches.
