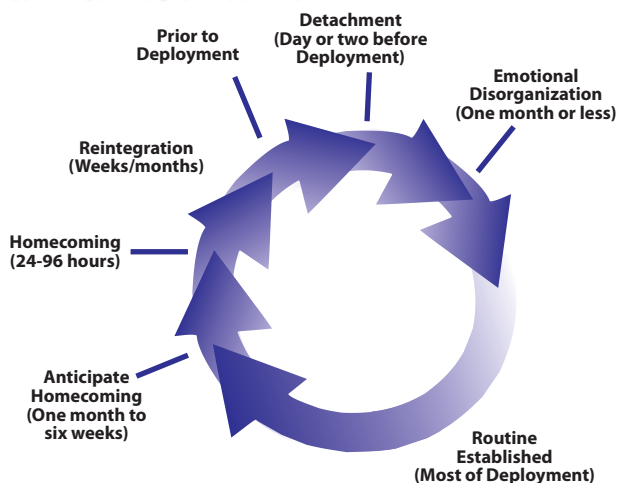


Emotional Cycle of Deployment

The School Liaison Officer (SLO) is the central point of contact for school-related matters between NRRNW Commands, military families, and local school systems. The SLO specializes in serving military students and families, and offers a wide spectrum of services to include:

7 Core Functions of the SLO

1. School Transition Services
2. Deployment Support
3. Special Education System Navigation
4. Command, School, Community Communications
5. Home School Linkage and Support
6. Partnerships in Education
7. Post-Secondary Preparation

Eligibility for School Liaison Officer Services: SLOs serve families of active duty, guard, reservists and civilian employees of all military branches.
