Most programs currently use the student number for login. You can use the space below to keep this number on hand. If you point your smartphone's camera at the QR code below, you can access a link to the website for more information.

 	<p>All Everett School District teachers will use Canvas as their learning management system. All learning will be housed within the Canvas platform.</p> <p>Student Access to Canvas – open Chrome (or other internet browser).</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• From a district device, students will log on to the computer using their student number.<ul style="list-style-type: none">◦ Click on the Canvas button to be directed to the teacher's page.• From a non-district device, open everettsd.org.<ul style="list-style-type: none">◦ Click on the Students Tab, then click on the Canvas button. <p>Parent Access to Canvas - App:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• parents can track their child's learning using the Canvas for Parents App. This app is available for both Android and iPhone users. Once downloaded, you will be prompted to connect to your child's distance learning classroom.
 	<p>All elementary students will use iReady to provide each individual learner with a personal path toward proficiency in Reading and Mathematics. Students will take diagnostic assessments and then follow a learning progression specially designed to meet individual needs.</p> <p>Student Access to iReady:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• From the district homepage, click on the Students tab. Then, click on the iReady visual.<ul style="list-style-type: none">◦ Log on using your student number.• From Canvas – many teachers will have a link to iReady on their Canvas homepage.
 	<p>Zoom is the video conferencing program that teachers will use for live teaching. There is an online and an app version.</p> <p>Student Access to Zoom:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• There are two ways to enter a meeting:<ul style="list-style-type: none">◦ Teachers will post Zoom links on their Canvas sites. Click on the link, then type in the meeting password when prompted.◦ From the web: Go to Zoom.us, click 'Join A Meeting', then type in the Meeting ID and Password.
 	

 	<p>Flipgrid & Padlet are applications that allow students to submit responses to discussions and assignments. Flipgrid is for video responses, and Padlet is used mostly for text and photo responses.</p> <p>Student Access to Flipgrid & Padlet:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Teachers will post a learning question or prompt, along with a link to Flipgrid or Padlet. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Click on the link, record your response, then submit. ○ Your teacher will review responses before posting – it may take a little while to see a student response.
 	<p>All English Language Learning elementary students will use Imagine Learning to provide each individual learner with a personal path of growth in Reading and Writing. Students follow a learning progression specially designed to meet individual needs.</p> <p>Student Access to IL&L:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • From the district homepage, click on the Students tab. Then, click on the Imagine Learning visual. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Log on using your student number. • From Canvas – many teachers will have a link to Imagine Learning on their Canvas homepage.
 	<p>Seesaw is an application that allows younger students to interact with their teachers and classmates.</p> <p>Student Access to SeeSaw:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Teachers will post a SeeSaw link in their Canvas Classroom <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Click on the link to open and log in using the student number.
