Everett High School PTA encourages respectful conversation and debate. Members participating are responsible for their own conduct, taking personal responsibility for their comments, username, and any information they provide. While the Everett High School PTA welcomes questions and comments in an open forum, it is mindful to remember manners and courtesy so everyone feels comfortable participating.

To keep an open and constructive dialogue, it is insisted that all of our social media audience (i.e. Facebook friends, Twitter followers) adhere to the guidelines listed below. Everett High School PTA reserves the right to remove any comment that does not comply with the following guidelines:

- Respect other members' positions and philosophies.
- Off-topic posts of any kind will not be allowed; please keep comments and posts clean and relevant.
- Everett High School PTA does not allow graphic, obscene, explicit, or racial comments or posts. In addition, Everett High School PTA does not allow comments that are abusive, hateful, or intended to defame anyone or any association; harassment and bullying of any kind will not be tolerated.
- Advertisements, endorsements, or promotions of third party solicitations will not be allowed.
- To maintain nonpartisanship, endorsements or opposition of political candidates are not allowed. Any posts by others about a candidate is not an endorsement or opposition by the Everett High School PTA.
- Comments that suggest or encourage illegal activity will not be tolerated.
- Spam is not allowed and will be removed. Information that is not accurate will also be removed.
- Personal information including email addresses, telephone numbers, mailing addresses, or any type of identification numbers will be removed.
