## College Checklist

### October

- If you are unsure about your plans after high school, talk with a trusted adult or schedule an appointment with your counselor or Mrs. Selders to talk about your options.
- If you are applying via Common App, create an account and match accounts in Naviance.
- If you are applying directly on a college's website, create your account so you can apply.
- Apply for Financial Aid (FAFSA/WASFA) starting October 1

### October - January

- Apply for colleges/universities using Common App or through the institution's website. Pay attention to deadlines.
- Request initial transcripts be sent to your schools through Naviance>Colleges>Manage Transcripts
- Have an adult review your application essay(s)
- Apply for regional/national/school specific scholarships
  - EHS Website>Counseling>College & Career>Scholarships

### January

- Apply for a Rotary scholarship (check school email for information and the application).

### February - March

- Apply for local and EHS scholarships (check school email for information and application)
- Review financial aid packages sent from schools you were admitted to.
- Apply to community college, trade and tech schools if you haven't already.

### April

- Make a decision about where you will attend and accept their offer of admission by May 1.

### April-June

- Accept all or part of your financial aid package if you choose to.
- Follow instructions sent via email from your chosen institution about registration, housing, meal plans, etc.
