MESSAGE FROM THE PRINCIPAL

Greetings Penny Creek Families,

Springtime here at Penny Creek is full of traditions. One of those traditions is statewide testing. We have been working to prepare your student to be successful on these assessments by creating learning activities focused on all of the learning standards. We have also provided many opportunities to take practice assessments. Now, we ask that you help us with the final stages of preparation by:

- Making sure your child is well-rested and eats a good breakfast before school.
- Avoiding last-minute morning rush by laying out clothes in advance or leaving for school a little early. It is imperative that students arrive on time to school as testing will begin at the start of the school day.
- Encouraging your child to do their best. Reminding them to stay calm during the test. In addition to knowing the concepts that will be tested, keys to a successful testing experience are reducing anxiety and stress, building confidence and promoting motivation and perseverance.
- Having your child bring a healthy snack such as dried fruit, string cheese, pretzels, etc. on their testing days.
- Not planning early pick-ups or scheduling doctor, dentist, or other appointments during testing times.

Thank you for your help and support throughout this five-week testing window.
