Dear Jackson HS Seniors:

Congratulations! Enclosed you will find information regarding your <u>senior portraits</u> for the Jackson HS yearbook. Please take note of all important due dates. Yearbook has strict deadlines for submission, so unfortunately, exceptions can rarely be made.

Senior portrait Information:

In order for the senior section to be consistent, attractive and professional, please share the following senior portrait guidelines with your photographer:

Print size: W x H: 2" x 3" (wallet size), vertical orientation.

Digital requirements: 400 dpi

No gag photos or selfies, and no studio names or watermarks.

The photo requirements apply no matter which studio you choose.

You can also have your senior picture taken on picture day (September 6th and retakes are October 11th) By Dorian Photography at Jackson HS at <u>no charge</u>. If you use your school photo, they will automatically be submitted to the yearbook staff. There is no other opportunity for pictures at Jackson HS other than picture day, so make sure you dress the way you would like to be featured in the yearbook.

All pictures are due to yearbook staff by <u>Friday</u>, <u>October 19th</u>. Studios may take 3 to 4 weeks from the time of the sitting to give you a disc to turn in, so make your appointments early. *If you do not submit a studio portrait (or have a Dorian picture taken on picture day)*, your senior picture will not be featured in the yearbook!

CD's containing your senior portrait should be turned in to JHS yearbook advisor Tami Johnson's mailbox in the JHS main office, or submitted electronically to <u>jacksonhsseniors@gmail.com</u>. Hard copies of photos are not accepted.

Don't forget to buy your yearbook early—JHS traditionally sells out their yearbook!
