



# 2020-2021 YEARBOOK UPDATE 12/16/2020

*T-Wolf Community: It has been brought to our attention that some parents had difficulty purchasing a yearbook online on Monday, December 14, which was the last day to purchase the yearbook. We have also received emails and phone calls from families asking for extensions to purchase the yearbook and to submit a Selfie Portrait.*

*We have extended the deadline to this **Friday, December 18, at 9:00 p.m.** for both purchasing the yearbook and submitting a Selfie Portrait. We order a limited number of yearbooks, and that order is based on the number of yearbooks that we sell during the pre-sale windows. We always have two pre-sale windows—one at the beginning of the school year and the second before Winter Break. As of this morning, we have only received pictures from 750 students; we are missing 1,480 student pictures. Any pictures not submitted via Selfie Portraits by this Friday, December 18, at 9:00 p.m. will not be included in the yearbook.*

*If you are a senior and you submitted a senior portrait, you do not need to submit a picture via Selfie Portraits.*

***How will student pictures be incorporated in the yearbook?***

*Due to Covid-19 cases rising in our county, we are not having in-person pictures. We are allowing students or parents to submit selfie pictures using Selfie Portraits. It is recommended to log in and capture an image using a cell phone. See the next page for detailed information on Selfie Portraits.*

***What is the FINAL due date for Selfie Portraits?*** *The new deadline is Friday, December 18, 2020, at 9:00 p.m.*

***What is the FINAL date to purchase a yearbook?*** *The new deadline is Friday, December 18, 2020, at 9:00 p.m.*

***How much will the yearbook cost?*** *The yearbook cost is \$55.*

***Are student pictures from the previous year going to be used?***

*No. If we need to use a picture from a previous year, we will contact families. The objective is to get all our students to participate and submit selfie pictures.*

***Is the cost of the yearbook going to be reduced?***

*No, the cost of the yearbook will not be reduced. We are still incorporating the same amount of work with this publication, and over the past four years we have been reducing the cost of the book to make it more affordable for our students.*

***What happens if I don't submit a picture for the yearbook?***

*If a student does not submit a picture by Friday, December 18, 2020, at 9:00 p.m., that student will not be included in the yearbook.*

**Who do we contact if we have questions?**

**Will I get a confirmation email after I submit a picture through Yearbook Snap?**

There is no email sent after a picture has been submitted and no guarantee that your submitted photo(s) will be used in the yearbook. If you provided Selfie Portraits with your email address, you will get an email if your picture has been rejected.

**Will yearbooks be sold in June?**

Yes—but only IF we have extra yearbooks to sell. This will depend on the quantity of yearbooks we order, which will be based on the fall and December pre-order numbers.

**Can I get a refund?** No, once you have made a purchase you can't be issued a refund.

**If I am not in the area during yearbook distribution in the spring, how can I get my yearbook?**

**If the number of COVID cases has been reduced, will in-person pictures be rescheduled?**

No. As with any publication, we have deadlines that we have committed to with our vendor to meet our print date, and we don't have enough time or staffing to make this sudden change.

**9th, 10th, & 11th grade students**

Website that can be used on a phone or a computer (not an app). Purpose is to accept portraits taken live on your phone or home computer camera – phone recommended. Parent or student will log in with your student ID number. Please note: Pre-captured images cannot be submitted. If you choose to include your email, you will receive a confirmation email to the submitter approving or rejecting the portrait submitted, based on school guidelines.



**To be submitted by**

**ALL grade levels**

**Yearbook Snap** – an app and a website. Submit your candid images from students on daily life throughout the school year for consideration in the yearbook. In the “NOTES” section, please include your first/last name and a description of what you and your friends are doing (student) or what your child is doing (parent/guardian).
