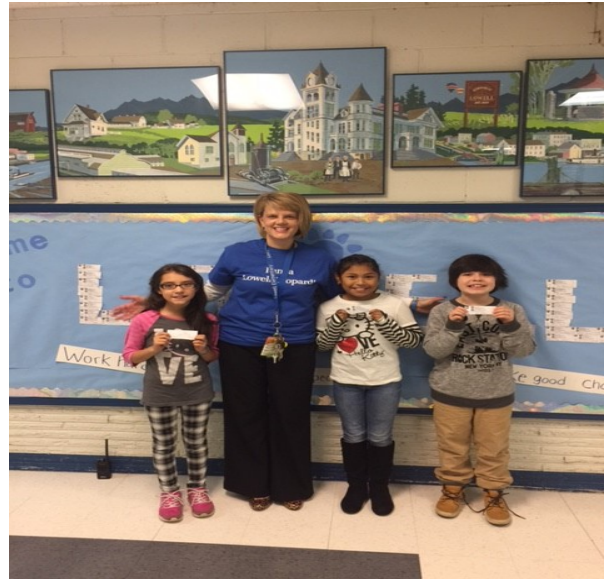
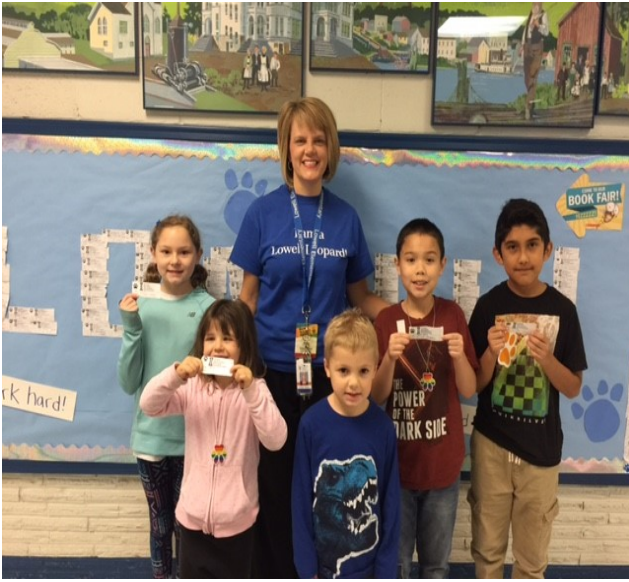
Lowell Elementary is participating in the Everett Elks stuffed animal and book drive this year!
