Who are Natural Leaders?

Natural Leaders are multi-cultural parents and family members that serve as a bridge between families, community, and students.

Why are they needed?

What do they do?

OUR PROGRAM

The Natural Leaders Program has been growing for sixteen years and was developed by WABS in 2003 with parents in Shoreline, Everett, Edmonds, Mukilteo, and Northshore schools with funding from an OSPI Readiness to Learn grant.

The WABS Natural Leaders Program uses an assetbased model to help families identify and cultivate the skills necessary to help overcome systemic barriers.
