Cedar Wood Library Android Tablet Acceptable Use and Permission Form

Our library now has e-books available for check out through your child's Destiny library account. Students may check out and view the e-books on computers or any Nook, Kindle, Android, or Apple tablet or smart phone that is able to download the BryteWave app (see our library website for details). Our library has purchased six Digiland 7 inch Android tablets that may be



checked out for up to a two week time period in order to read downloaded ebooks. A wide variety of both fiction and nonfiction e-books have been purchased for our library. We encourage parents to be actively involved with their children's reading selections by discussing book choices, reading together, and talking about literature.

The chance to use this device is a privilege we are able to offer students provided that students use extra caution and take responsibility. When a student checks out a tablet, they will log in as the "student" user, which has restricted access. The main applications students should be using are the Brytewave App, Destiny Quest, and internet browser (when trying to connect to WiFi at school.) When students take the tablet home, they will need to connect to your home's WiFi. If you do not have a WiFi connection at home, students will need to download any e-books they checked out at school before heading home. WiFi connections are not needed once the e-books have been downloaded to the Brytewave application on the tablet. Each Digiland tablet is valued at \$65, including accessories and cover. We require parent consent before a tablet can be checked out to students.

Parent Responsibilities and Permission

I am authorizing the assignment of an Android tablet to my child. I understand that it is to be used as a tool for reading and learning, and my child will comply with the Everett School District's technology Acceptable Use Policy. I will help ensure a safe and timely return of the Android tablet within the 2 week loan period. I also understand that I am financially responsible for loss or any willful, malicious, or accidental damage to the tablet (\$65 replacement cost or comparable tablet replacement), as well as any charges resulting from downloading additional materials. I understand that my child may lose future loan privileges of the device if the tablet is either damaged or not returned in a timely manner. *I **understand** that my child is not to download materials on the device other than the specific e-books checked out and will be reminded to use the device and internet options responsibly. In addition, if the tablet is returned with any modifications or factory resets, that student will no longer have the opportunity to check out tablets from our library.
