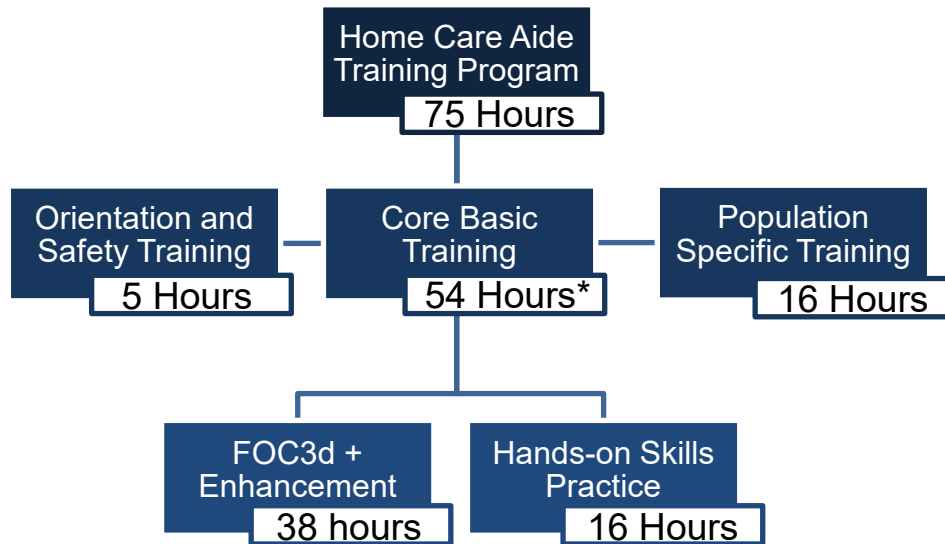


Introduction to the Home Care Aide Training Program

Orientation and Safety Training must be completed before the long-term care worker can begin providing care (WAC 388-112A-0200 through 388-12A-0240)

Fundamentals of Caregiving (FOC) 3rd Edition covers the core competencies that describe the behavior, knowledge, and skills outlined for basic caregiver training in WAC 388-112A-0320

Enhancements mean additional time and training provided for skills practice and supplemental learning materials and/or classroom activities that help a long-term care worker to thoroughly learn the course content and skills. Enhancements may include new participant materials, videos or DVDs, online materials, and additional participant activities per WAC 388-112A-0300(4). Some suggestions for enhancements are included in this facilitator's guide.

Hands-on Skills Practice means hands-on skills practice in a lab setting or with clients while on the job based on the Skills Practice Procedure Checklist or Home Care Aides.
