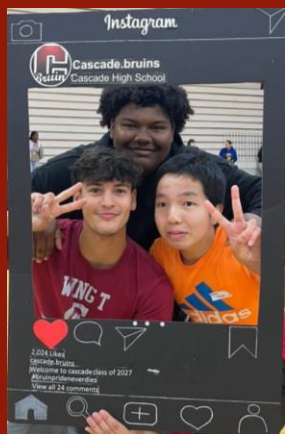

Grading Procedures

- GPAs are cumulative and computed at the close of each semester.
- Grades are recorded on the transcript and the GPA is computed in late January and June.
- Only courses with letter grades are calculated in the GPA.
- GPA is based on a 4-pt scale
- CHS does not weight grades.
- All subjects are included in determination of decile standing and GPA including College in the High School and Running Start.
