





# UNIQUE SCHEDULING FAQ'S

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- **Summer School:** \$350 / 0.5 credit. Students will register on the EPS district website (registration open on March 9<sup>th</sup>)
- **Zero Periods at JHS include:** (1) Jazz Band, (2) Jazz Ensemble, or (3) ASB Leadership. Students *won't* enter these classes in *StudentVue*. If they get into Jazz Band, Choir, or run for an ASB office, they will be automatically enrolled.
- **High School Online classes & Signature STEM** – Students can add these options when registering within *StudentVUE*

**KEY:** PR = Prerequisite ..... You must satisfy a prerequisite to be qualified to take the course. Check the course catalog for details. *If you request a course you are not qualified to take, we reserve the right to add the prerequisite course(s) to your list of requests.*

R = Repeatable for credit You may take the course more than once – in fall semester or spring semester or both semesters. Select it twice if you wish to take it twice.

YR = Yearlong course The course will meet for the whole year.


