***If you plan to take any classes in the summer, please read the following important information!***

- Regardless of your summer school plans, for next school year, you must request whatever course normally comes after the course you're in now. We will make adjustments in August after we confirm successful completion of summer classes. **FOR EXAMPLE:** If you are currently taking Algebraic Concepts (Algebra 1) and you want to take Geometry in summer so you can take Adv Alg Conc (Alg 2) next year, you must request Geometry for next year, NOT Adv Alg. If you successfully complete Geometry in summer, we will bump you up to Adv Alg.
- For Everett Public Schools Summer Academy, be sure to take both parts of any course that is yearlong in the normal school year. **FOR EXAMPLE:** If you want to take Geometry in summer, you will need OMT217 and OMT218 for the complete Geometry course.
- If you take summer classes from somewhere other than Everett Public Schools Summer Academy, it is your responsibility to provide the JHS Registrar verification of your course completion.

**KEY:**    **PR = Prerequisite** ..... You must satisfy a prerequisite to be qualified to take the course. Check the course catalog for details. ***If you request a course you are not qualified to take, we reserve the right to add the prerequisite course(s) to your list of requests.***

**R = Repeatable for credit**    You may take the course more than once – in fall semester or spring semester or both semesters.

**YR = Yearlong course**        The course will meet for the whole year.
