

JHS Graduation Requirements

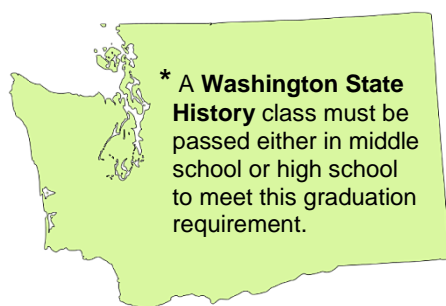
The goal of the Everett School District is to ensure that all students learn 21st century skills, reach high academic standards, and prepare for post-secondary education or training and career. Please refer to the chart below for graduation requirements.

Graduation Requirements

- A student in the classes of 2017–2020 must earn a total of **22** credits to graduate from Jackson High School and Everett Public Schools.
- Each semester-long class completed with a passing grade equals one-half (0.5) credit.
- A maximum of 1.0 total credit of Teacher Assistant or Office Assistant may be counted towards graduation requirements.
- Students must meet a math-based quantitative course requirement in their senior year. For more info, visit the [JHS Counseling website](#) or the district [Graduation](#) page under the Student tab.
- Until graduation requirements are met, students must carry six (6) classes per semester or have administrative permission for a partial schedule.
