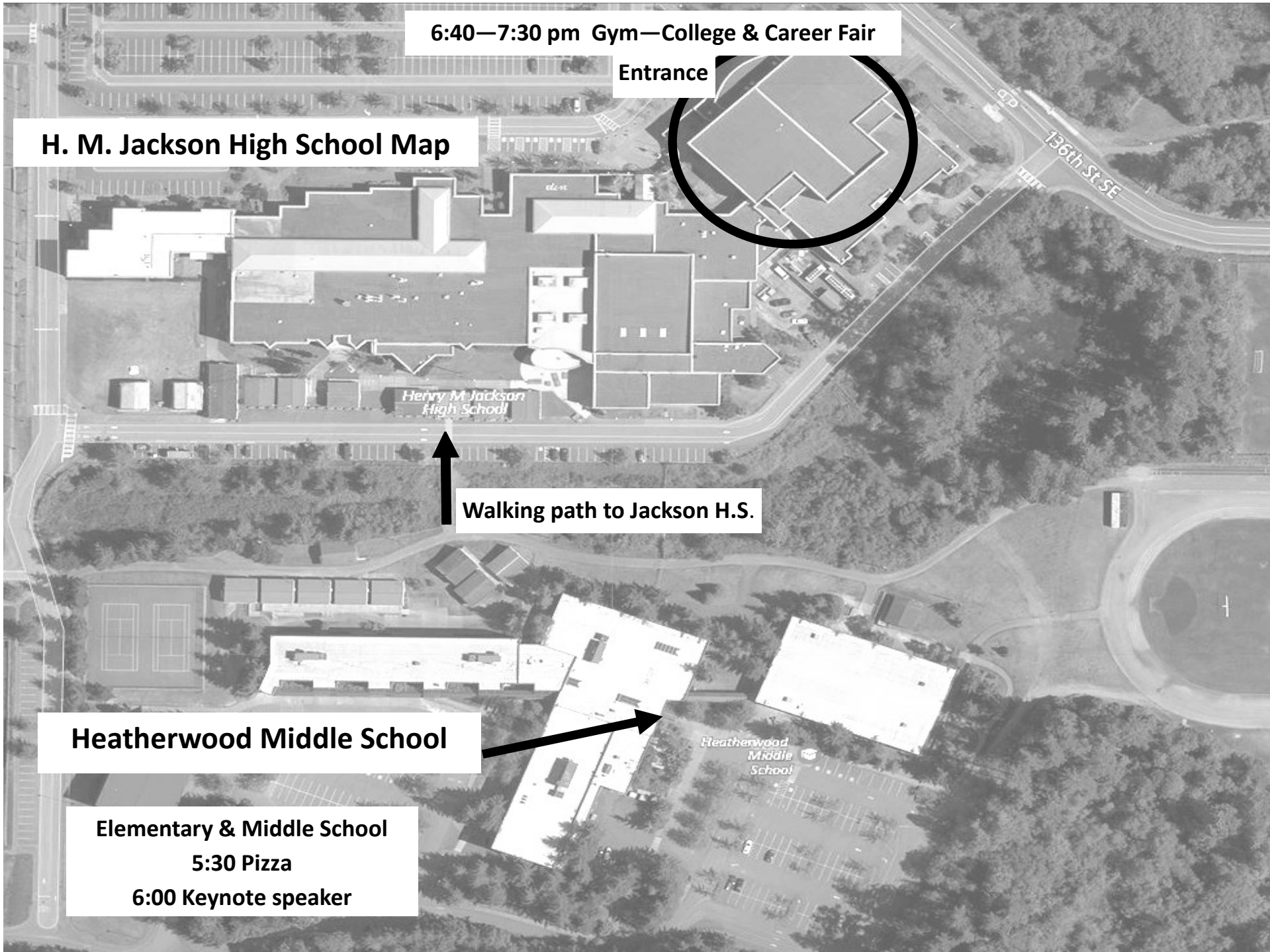
## **H.M. Jackson High School Gymnasium College and Career Fair!**
