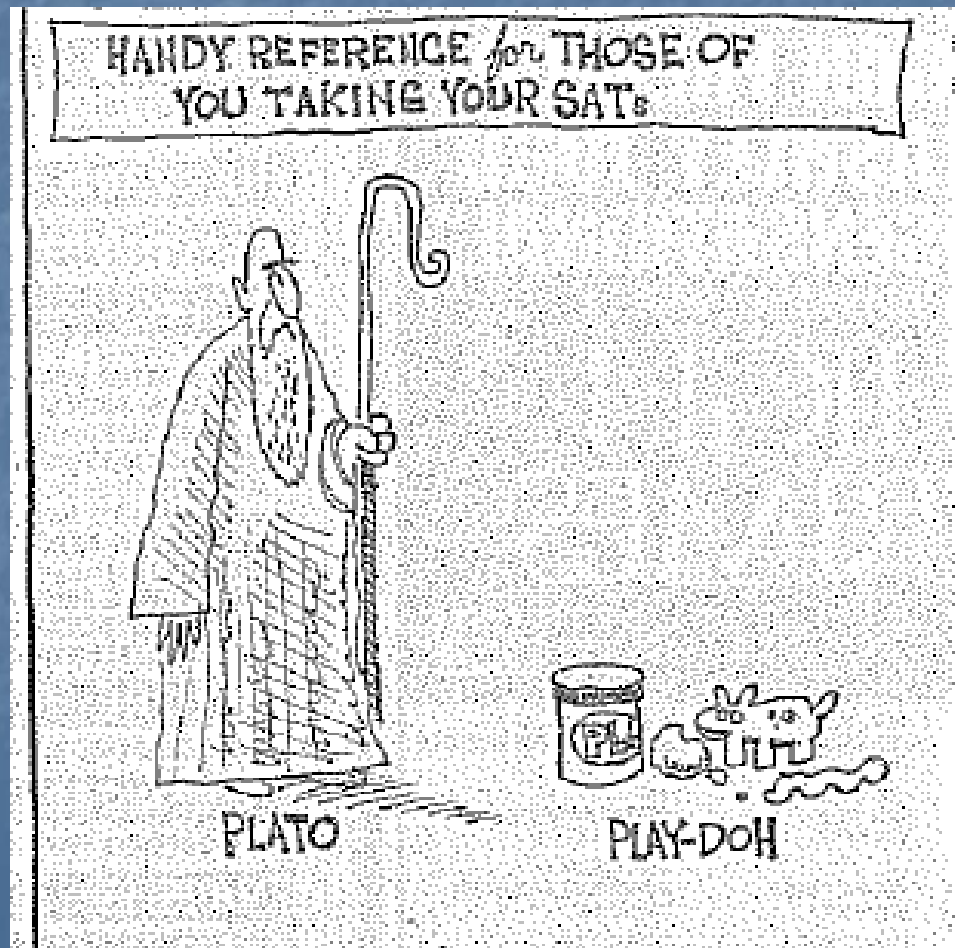

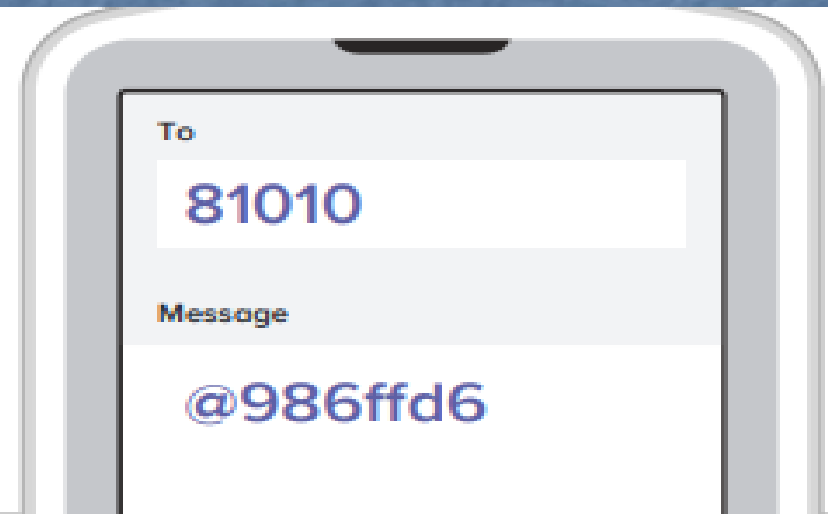

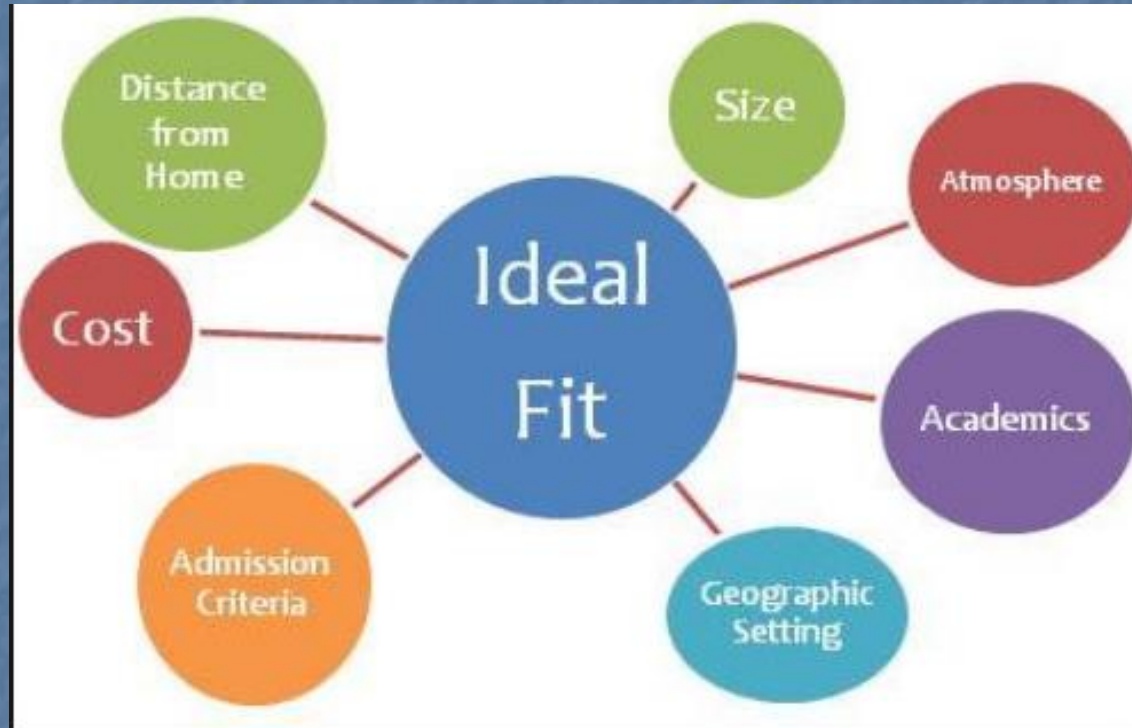

Finding the right school
for YOUR educational needs

Technical & Trade Colleges

- 1 to 2 year programs
- Provide training for skilled, high tech workers



Community Colleges

- 1 to 2 year programs
- Degrees & certificates offered
 - *academic transfer degrees,*
 - *professional-technical degrees*
 - *certificates of achievement.*

*Earning an *academic transfer degree* similar to completing the first 2 years at a 4-year college/university.



Four-Year Colleges & Universities

- Typically 4-year programs offering variety of Bachelor's degrees
- A university (as opposed to a college) also offers master's degrees (M.A., M.S.) and doctorates (Ph.D.) for advanced, highly specialized study.



Military Service

- Educational opportunities
 - Up to 90% tuition assistance for college courses
 - Technical training in over 200 skill areas
 - G.I. Bill-Tuition for any school



Internships

- An intern is a student undergoing supervised practical training.
- Real-life applications of the skills students learn in school.
- An internship is a way to "try on a job" before deciding on a career.

Apprenticeships

- Training program where you earn wages while learning a skilled profession in a specific field.
- Supervised by a trade professional
- Includes classroom studies and on-the-job training
- Earn a salary while you learn about your trade

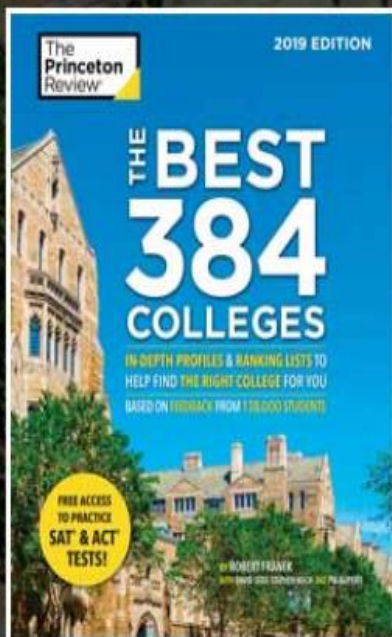

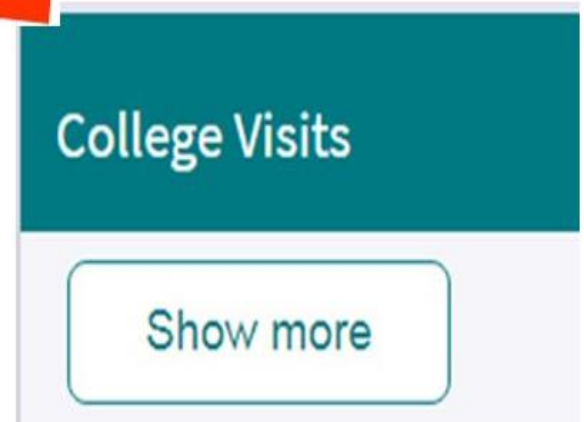
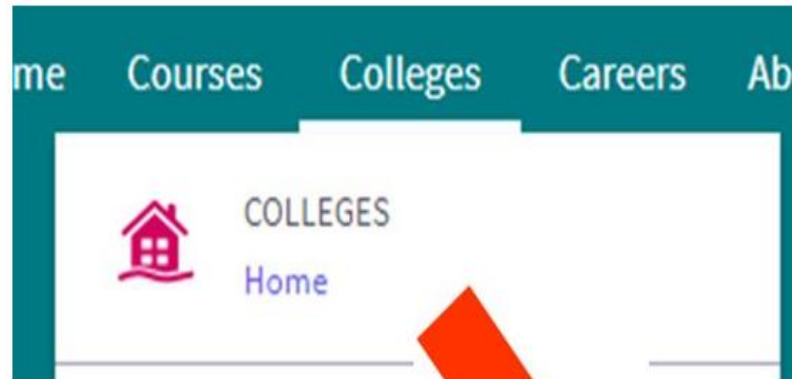

College Applications are now done **ONLINE**



- **Make sure your email address is appropriate**
 - **Suggestion:** *Set up an email account specifically for your college & scholarship applications that you will check regularly*
- **Make sure your email doesn't block "mass emails" from colleges/univ's**

Early Decision vs. Early Action

- **Early decision** plans are binding.
- **Early action** plans are similar to early decision plans, but are not binding.
- Rules may vary from college to college, so check with the college to which you are applying.

Requesting Transcripts



The **Colleges I'm applying to** list is where you move the colleges when you plan to submit applications.

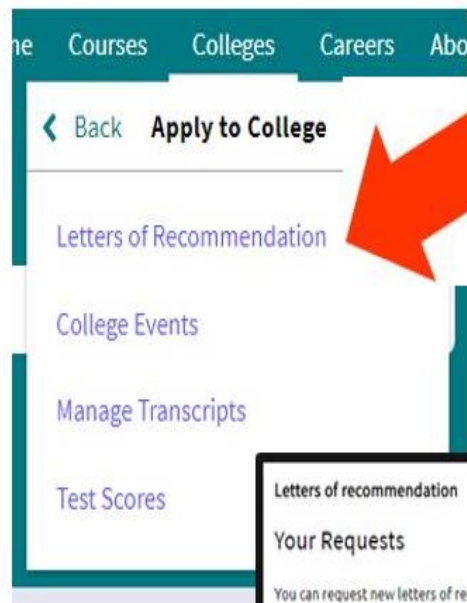

News from UW

- November 15 is UW's deadline for fall 2018 (*scores from Dec ACT/SAT okay – but have them sent right away!*)
- UW “pools” their decisions – ALL decisions mailed out the first 2 weeks of March
- UW only wants your final H.S. transcript in the spring after being admitted

Running Start & College-in-the-High-School students:

- (1) Send in Official Transcripts from any colleges attended**
- (2) You'll still apply as a Freshman Applicant**

Essay Tips

- Write about what is not covered in the rest of the application
- You should be the only person who can write your essay. Show who YOU are... YOUR voice... how events/people effected YOU.
- READ and FOLLOW the directions – answer the question



Essay Tips



- Be wary of “Tip of the Iceberg” and “Thesaurusitis” writing. OMG – also avoid “Txt Message” writing.
- Have someone proofread your writing & read it aloud (*spell check doesn't catch everything!*). Give yourself time!

- Most schools notify by April 1st. However, if you get your application in early, it's possible to hear much earlier

What's Important

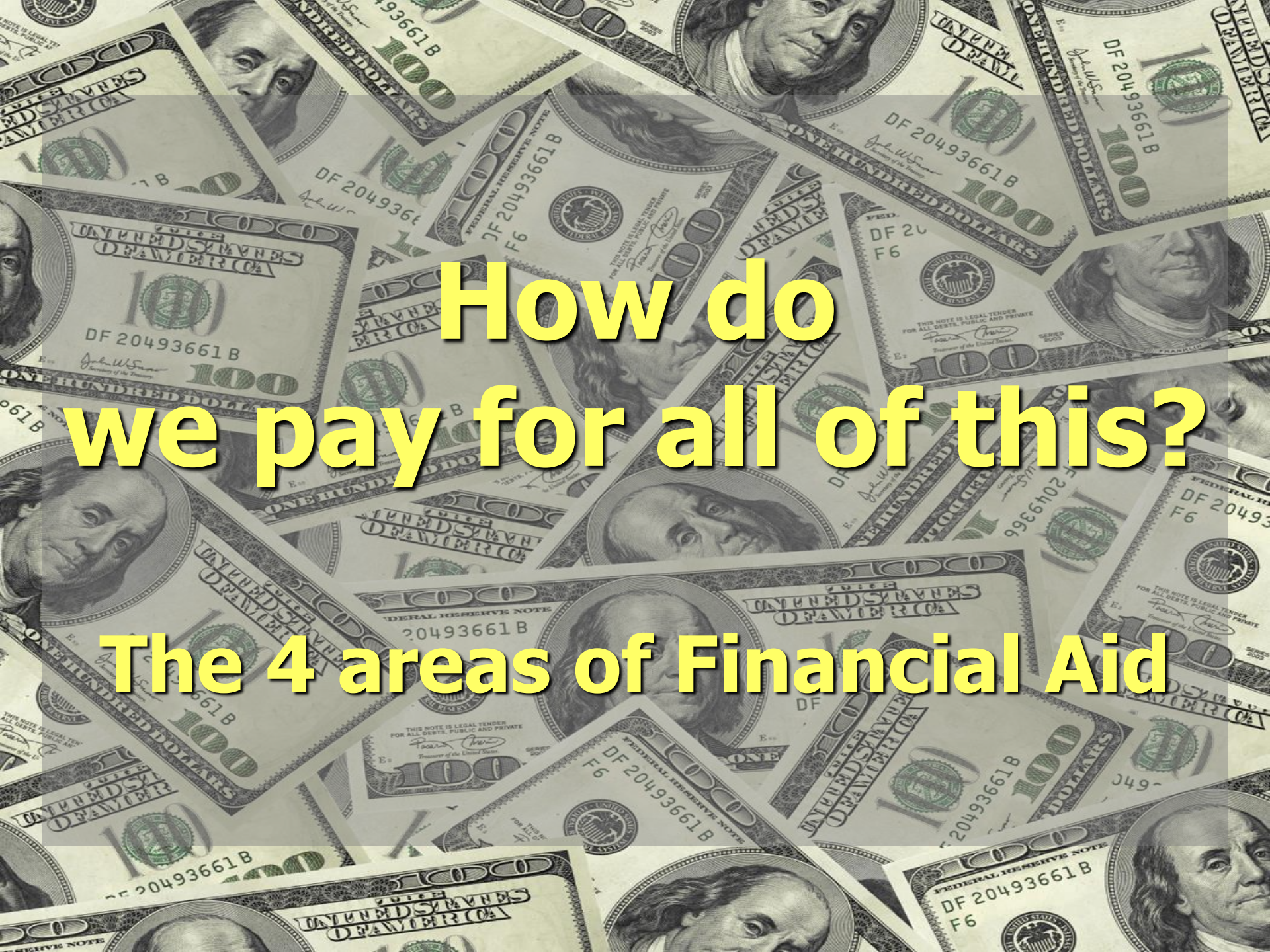


- High school curriculum quality
- GPA and SAT or ACT scores
- School activities, community services, leadership, responsibility for family or in employment
- Significant cultural awareness and contributions
- Ability to bring a unique perspective, background or ability to the student body
- Educational or economic disadvantage
- Overcoming personal adversity
- Exceptional artistic talent
- Personal statement writing quality

Public vs. Private

~ Let's talk money ~

- 2015 Whitworth graduates left college with approximately **\$28,800** debt.
The average in 2013 for UW graduates was approximately **\$21,900** debt *(from College in Sight)*
- Nearly 80% of students who graduate from WA State Private colleges do so in 4 years or less.

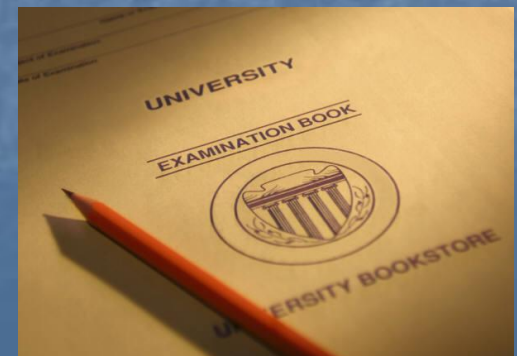
