Post-secondary refers to <u>any</u> college, training program and/or career plans after high school graduation.



Standardized tests (not required)

UC eliminated its standardized test requirement in 2020.

UC no longer considers SAT or ACT test scores when making admissions decisions or awarding scholarships. Test scores submitted as part of the application may be used as an alternate method of fulfilling minimum requirements for eligibility NYU will continue to remain test-optional for the 2024-2025 application cycle. 
Test-Flexible Policy


Sending Your Scores

You can have your ACT scores sent to other colleges and scholarship agencies, even after you test.







What is WUE?

The Western Undergraduate Exchange (WUE) is a tuition-savings program that makes attending out-of-state colleges and universities more affordable for students. Through WUE, you receive a reduced tuition rate, giving you more education options for your money. Virtually all undergraduate degrees are available.





How does WUE work?

Participating two- and four-year public colleges and universities across the Western U.S. agree to charge out-of-state students no more than 150 percent of the institution's in-state tuition. Tuition savings may vary depending on the college or major. The bottom line: You save big with WUE and almost always pay less than out-of-state tuition.

How do I get started?

Check your eligibility by home state/ territory, college and major through our online WUE Savings Finder. Visit wuesavingsfinder.wiche.edu or use the QR code.


