## Decile

*[ˈdeɪ.sɪ(-ə)]*

A quantitative method of splitting up a set of ranked data into 10 equally large subsections.



- JHS *doesn't* use a numerical GPA rank
- JHS uses a **decile standing** (Top 10%, Top 20%, Top 30%, etc.)
- Grades are "unweighted"

# Test Optional (SAT/ACT)



## Notre Dame is Test-Optional for the 2024 and 2025 Application Cycles

We have extended our test-optional admissions practice through the 2025 application year.

Our application opened August 1 and students may apply for admission via the Common Application, the Coalition Application, or the QuestBridge Application.



## Standardized tests (not required)

UC eliminated its standardized test requirement in 2020.

UC no longer considers SAT or ACT test scores when making admissions decisions or awarding scholarships.


NYU is extending its test-optional policy to students applying for first-year or transfer admission during the 2023-2024 admissions cycle.

Harvard College will allow students to apply for admission without requiring SAT or ACT scores for the upcoming Harvard College Classes of '27, '28, '29, and '30.

Students who do not submit standardized test scores will not be disadvantaged in their application process. Applicants will be considered on the basis of what they have presented, and students are encouraged to send whatever materials they believe would convey their accomplishments in secondary school and their promise for the future.

**Boston College will maintain a test-optional admission policy for the 2023-24 application cycle.**

We get it—things change. While we still automatically send your scores from the ACT test to the places you requested when you registered (including both your high school and college score recipients), something may have changed since then. Maybe you've got your eye on a new college, have a chance at an unexpected scholarship, or accidentally left off the university you toured last semester.

You can have your ACT scores sent to other colleges and scholarship agencies, even after you test.





# Financial Aid



## Better FAFSA/WASFA 2024-25

Dear Education Partner,

Big changes are coming to financial aid applications this year. The [Washington Student Achievement Council \(WSAC\)](#) would like to team with you to help students and families navigate these changes.

Firstly, the **2024-25 FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) will not be available until December 2023**. The WASFA (Washington Application for State Financial Aid) will also be delayed until the FAFSA opens. Applications usually open October 1 of a student's senior year, so this is a major shift in the college planning process.

The good news is that this delay is due to positive changes in the financial aid application process:

- The FAFSA form will be shorter and less complex.
- More students will be eligible for federal Pell Grants, and the average Pell award will be larger.

The Western Undergraduate Exchange (WUE) is a tuition-savings program that makes attending out-of-state colleges and universities more affordable for students. Through WUE, you receive a reduced tuition rate, giving you more education options for your money. **Virtually all undergraduate degrees are available.**

### How does WUE work?

Participating two- and four-year public colleges and universities across the Western U.S. agree to charge out-of-state students no more than 150 percent of the institution's in-state tuition. Tuition savings may vary depending on the college or major. **The bottom line: You save big with WUE and almost always pay less than out-of-state tuition.**

### How do I get started?




