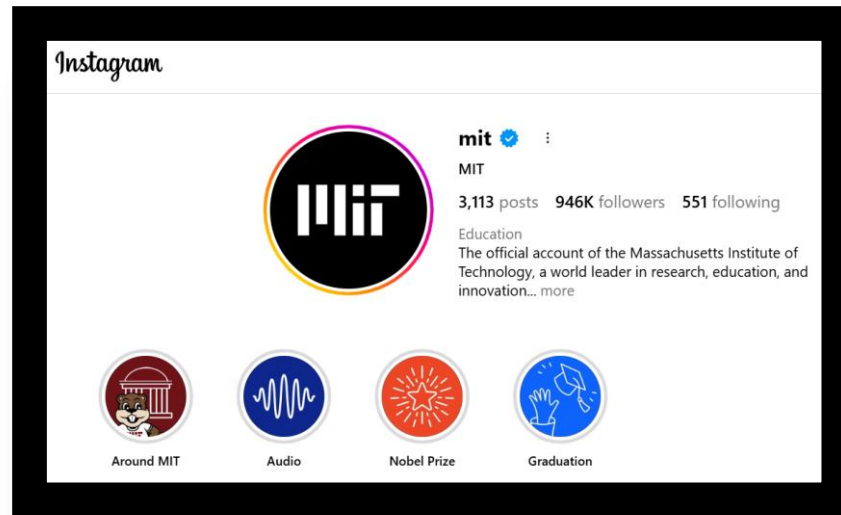

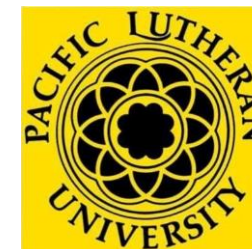

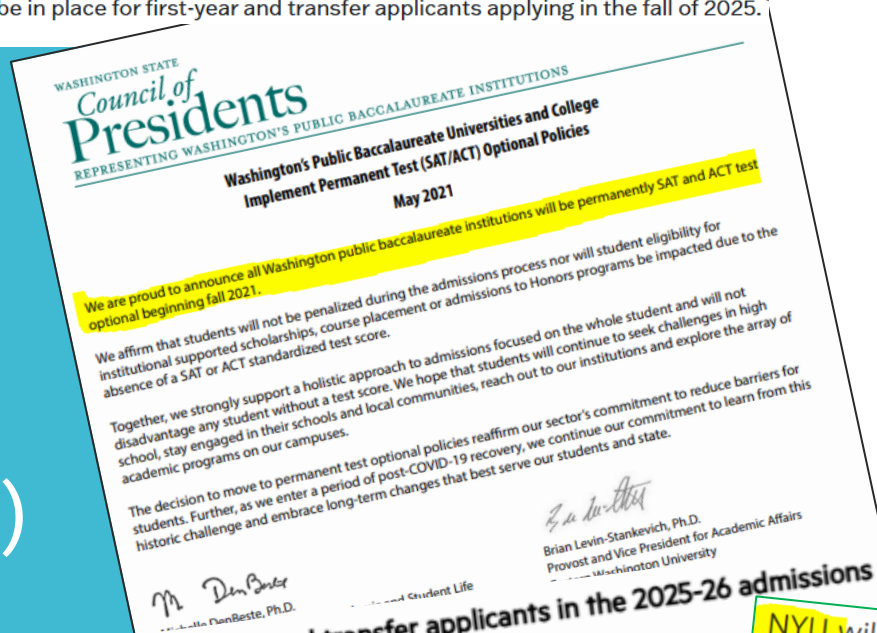

Duke University will be test-optional for both first-year and transfer applicants in the 2025-26 admissions cycle.

Students who apply without SAT or ACT scores this year will not be at a disadvantage in our admissions.

3. Standardized tests

Notre Dame is test-optional for all applicants through the 2025-26 school year, meaning ACT and/or SAT scores are not required. This policy applies to both first-year and transfer students. That said, significant quantitative evidence is typically demonstrated by our strongest applicants.

Boston College has a test-optional admission policy. Students who opt not to submit test scores will receive full consideration during our selection process.

Columbia is test-optional for applicants to Columbia College and Columbia Engineering.

Standardized tests (not required)

UC eliminated its standardized test requirement in 2020.

UC no longer considers SAT or ACT test scores when making admissions decisions or awarding scholarships. Test scores

submitted as part of the application may be used as an alternate method of fulfilling minimum requirements for eligibility

after matriculation at UC.

NYU will continue to remain test-optional through the 2025-2026 application cycle. For students who elect to submit testing as part of their application, NYU has one of the most flexible testing policies of any college or university.







How does WUE work?

The Western Undergraduate Exchange (WUE) is a tuition savings program that makes attending out-of-state colleges and universities more affordable for students. Through WUE, you receive a reduced tuition rate, giving you more education options for your money.

Out-of-state tuition is expensive, sometimes two to three times the cost of in-state tuition. With WUE, participating public colleges and universities across the West agree to charge out-of-state students no more than 150% of the school's in-state tuition. Tuition savings may vary depending on the college or major. **The bottom line: You save big with WUE and almost always pay less than out-of-state tuition.**

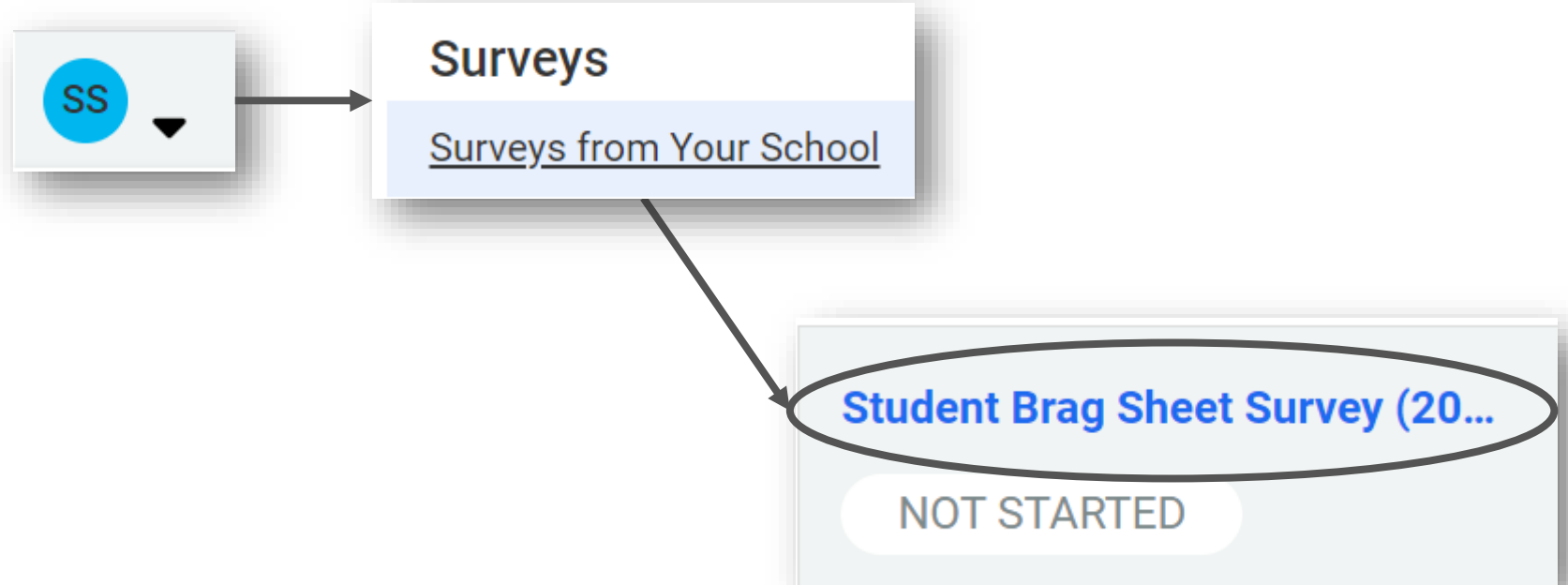


