Frequently Asked Questions**Can my student move from Math 6 to Accelerated Math 7?**

If a student moved from Math 6 to Accelerated Math 7, they would be missing 1 semester's worth of foundational math concepts. In order to bridge this gap in instruction, Everett Public Schools offers a summer course called Bridge to Accelerated Math 7. Students must complete this course with a passing grade. Please let your Math 6 teacher and school counselor know if you are interested in taking the Bridge to Accelerated Math 7 summer course so you can take Accelerated Math 7 next year.

Can my student move from Accelerated Math 6 to Algebraic Concepts?

If a student moved from Accelerated Math 6 to Algebraic Concepts, they would be missing 1.5 years worth of foundational math concepts. Due to this large gap in instruction, there currently is no pathway to bridge between these two courses.

Can my student move from English 6 to Honors English 8?

Yes, dependent upon the student's progress in English 6, test scores, and teacher recommendation. Please let your English 6 teacher and school counselor know if you are interested in taking Honors English 8 next year.

What happens next with 7th grade registration for the 2025-2026 school year?

Upon completion of this form, please turn it in to your Science teacher by Wednesday, March 18th. Ms. Freeman will work with all 6th graders in their Science classes the week of March 23rd so they can officially input their course requests into StudentVue.

I'm interested in Yearbook. How do I apply?

You can find the application forms for Yearbook on the Heatherwood Counseling website during the week of course registration. March 23rd-25th. They will also be sent out to all students and families.

When will I receive my schedule for 7th grade year?

Student schedules for the 2025-26 school year will be available in late August.

What if I change my mind about my course requests?

Students will have the opportunity to request a schedule changes after the first three days of school. Counselors will open their schedule change request forms on Tuesday, September 2nd on the HMS Counseling website.
