It may seem early, but we are already beginning to plan for the 2025-2026 school year and we are excited for students to select courses for next year. Please take time to review all the materials and discuss middle school course choices carefully. Your student's current teacher is a great resource when making 6<sup>th</sup> grade class selections.

Our student registration materials include a middle school course catalog (formatted to match the high school course catalog) and registration worksheet. Guidance on course registration, and advanced pathways will be presented by 5<sup>th</sup> grade teachers and can be found in the middle school course catalog. Students and parents should review the course catalog to find grade level information and resources for planning next year's course choices. Please contact one of our counselors or administrators with any questions.

- Students must complete their registration worksheet and return to their current teacher prior to Friday, March 7<sup>th</sup>.
- After March 7<sup>th</sup>, students will enter registration selections into Home Access Center during the school day with assistance from teachers and counselors.
- Honors Pathway for English and Math should begin in 6<sup>th</sup> grade to avoid having to take a summer school bridge class to change a pathway in 7<sup>th</sup> or 8<sup>th</sup> grade.
- Students must select a minimum of one semester of a Visual or Performing Art (VPA) Elective.
- Students must select alternatives for electives (elective choices are not guaranteed; we do our best to honor preferences).
- Schedule changes are not made once students are registered for classes.
  Staffing/course offerings are based on registration worksheet selections.
