Important arrival, dismissal eakfast information

School begins at 8:35 and ends at 2:50. Please be prompt in getting your child to and from school.

Breakfast begins at 8:00 and ends at 8:30. Tardy bell is at 8:35. Students who are late can have yogurt, juice and toast in the cafeteria. Students who are arrived after 9:00 will receive a cheese stick and go straight to class.

Attendance is very important. We recognize students and classrooms that have great attendance by providing them with a certificate at our HAWK Pride Assemblies. Classrooms who receive ALL HERE-7 days with perfect attendance- receive a Hawk trophy to display in their classrooms. We also announce this on the morning announcements. If possible, make doctor appointments after school or on days that we do not have school. We need every child picked up on time. We cannot babysit students in the office due to parents running late. Please have a plan for emergencies.

We are asking parents to notify the office by 2:00pm if you have an alternate way your child will be going home. Calling at 2:30 is too close to our dismissal time and the office staff is very busy at that time. Messages are difficult to get to teachers last minute.
