COVID-19 Attestation:

Any student that is participating in any in-building or school related event must have a COVID-19 Attestation form on file. If you have submitted one for in-person instruction, no action is needed. If you have a remote student then an attestation form must be completed to participate in the following events: senior celebration, graduation practice, and the graduation ceremony. Senior Device and School Materials Collection June 16

On June 16, seniors will be turning in all school materials, including their devices and all of the accessories (charging cord, stylus, Hotspot if one has been checked out), as well as any textbooks or school equipment. At that time, the devices turned in should be free of any stickers or any other additions that were not a part of the original device. **Students must turn in their school materials in order to participate in graduation practice.** Note: there may be some special circumstances for individual students.

Graduation Tickets

Per new guideline received, we can now have 5,000 audience members at the commencement ceremony. With our estimated number of graduates, each senior will receive eight (8) tickets for friends and family to attend. Household members must sit together and be socially distanced from other families by the indicators on the bleachers.

Graduation Practice

Practice will be on **Friday, June 18th here at Jackson High School from 9:00-1:00** (we may end early). All seniors will be participating in rehearsal at one time, we ask that student arrive to the gym and immediately sit in the assigned seat and keep a mask on at all times. If a senior has other commitments or Running Start exams, we will have a method communicated on Thursday, June 17th that will include seating assignments. **Students must participate in graduation rehearsal to be a part of the ceremony.** Currently practice is scheduled to be in the GYM and students should start entering at 9:00 a.m. on Friday, June 18th.

The senior celebration will be on Saturday, June 12th from 6:00-9:00 pm at Lord Hill Farms in Snohomish. This will be a Jackson senior-only event (no guests). Seniors that choose to participate must have an attestation form on file, in exchange for a ticket. Seniors can dress formally or casually. Games, food, and entertainment will be arranged. Tickets are free and will be available at the ASB Office on June 2nd (from 8-2:30 pm), and June 7th and 8th (from 1:30 pm – 4:00 pm).

Students must bring a form of picture ID to be issued a ticket. Tickets will be at no cost this year instead we will be collecting donations to support the Mill Creek Food Bank. All participating seniors must have a ticket to be allowed entry at the venue. 1 ticket will be issued per senior. Tickets can't be placed on hold, and each student must arrive in-person to obtain a ticket. At the event, please help ensure proper social distancing protocols are followed, and masks are always on.

Senior Graduation Parade 2021

The City of Mill Creek wants to recognize all graduating seniors in the Mill Creek community by organizing a graduation parade procession at 10 a.m. on Saturday, June 12, 2021. The parade is a way to celebrate students during this difficult year and celebrate their ability to overcome the obstacles from the pandemic. The parade capacity is limited to 250 cars for all graduating seniors in the Mill Creek area. The parade route is approximately seven miles long and begins at Jackson High School, 1508 136th St. SE, in Mill Creek. The route will end at the intersection of Mill Creek Boulevard and Bothell-Everett Highway (SR 527).

Seniors are encouraged to decorate their vehicles for the parade with balloons, glass chalk or window paint, poster boards, etc. Community members are asked to cheer on the students as they drive by and to decorate their homes.

Home window signs are available for community members on the City's website to print and display at their homes. Signs will include various school crests, and offer an easy for our residents to show support for our graduates.

The City of Mill Creek recommends a parent, or non-graduating student drive, so graduates may participate in waving and enjoy the parade route as a passenger. Students are welcome to carpool together and follow COVID-19 safety guidelines.

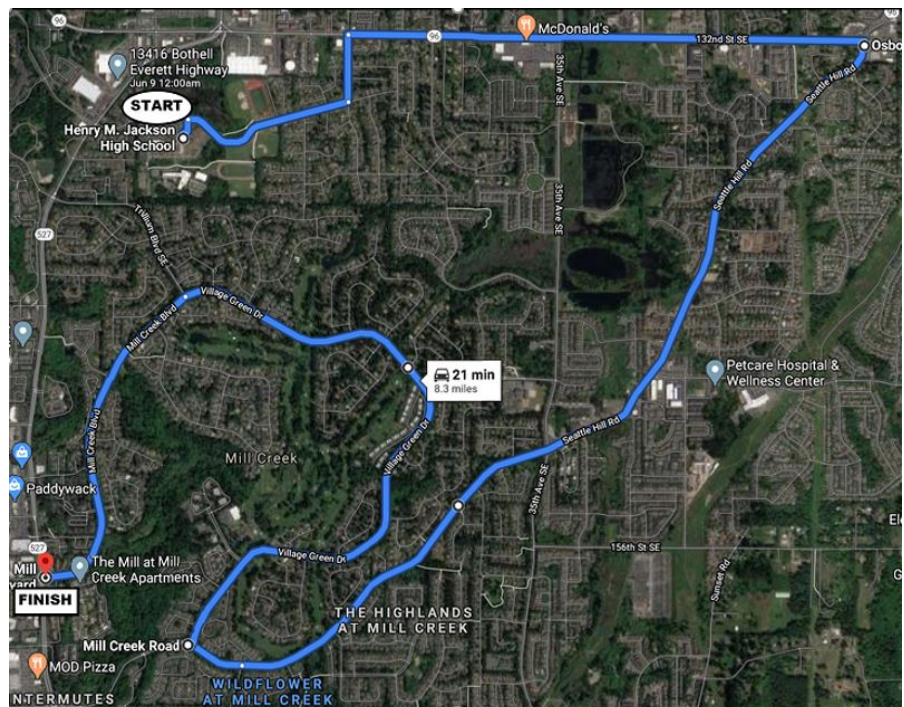
