



GRADUATION 2020!

Hello, amazing Timberwolf Seniors... As we approach the “big day,” we want to be sure you have all the information you need for this to be a smooth and special event for you and your family!

This is how it’s going to work...

- On Friday, **June 12th**, the graduating seniors of JHS will arrive at the **south parking lot** of the **Everett Memorial Stadium**.
- You will use the main driveway entrance of the Everett Public Schools Community Resource Center located on 40th Street (see photo on pg 2).
- We will have a decorated covered stage in the far south end of the parking lot.
- One car per family, only family members will be allowed in the car.
- Each car must have the graduate’s name clearly displayed on the dashboard (preferably on an 8x11 piece of paper).
- Graduates also need to bring their name on a piece of paper with their name phonetically spelled out to hand to the reader. Please print clearly.
- Each family, will drive up to the stage, let their graduate get out of the car and walk across the stage while being recorded and photographed.
- This recording will be consolidated into a final digital celebration (approx. one week later) and will also allow parents to personally see their student walk across the stage.
- Parents will proceed to the viewing area. Parents are to remain in their car (unless with prior approval for student assistance needs).
- The best view will be through the lens of the cameras of the production company. You won’t need to try to capture the perfect picture, the photographer will do that for us. 😊
- **Graduate must wear a mask** until they walk across the stage.
- As soon as the graduate walks across the stage, they must get back in the car and immediately leave the parking area.
- **Out of respect for all other graduates**, families should cheer only after your graduate’s name is read and until they exit the stage. Another graduate will be immediately behind ready to cross the stage. We do not want to take away from their moment on stage. Since this is a recorded production, we want to make sure the next graduate’s name is heard.

- Because this has been a very unique and difficult spring for seniors, you will be allowed to decorate the **top** of your graduation cap for this commencement.
- In addition to your Cap, Gown, and Tassel, you may wear the following approved items:
 - Your Class of 2020 medallion
 - Honor cords (distributed on Friday, June 9th as eligible)
 - Valedictorian medal
 - Departmental scholar medal
 - If appropriate to your custom, an item of cultural celebratory significance (such as an authentic flower or wooden lei or Native American feathers)
- The seniors should arrive within the time slots listed below. Students who have to work around parent work schedules or have other conflicts can come at a time that works for the specific circumstance. The goal is to have the graduation filmed in a reasonable alpha order.
