For the first time in two years, the Jackson High School robotics team; FRC Team 2910: Jack in the Bot, returned to regular district play at the Glacier Peak District FRC Event. This year's game, Rapid React sponsored by Boeing, kicked off for all FRC teams on January 8. After a rigorous 8-week build season, the team's robot, Thor, made its debut this weekend at Glacier Peak High School. The robot drive team — Darlina Phan, Drew Middleton, Eric Gibson, and William Harris — steered the robot through a dozen qualification rounds, ending as the number 1 seed with a record of 11-1-0. Along with partner teams, Stealth Robotics from Duvall and 4-H Botsmiths from Snohomish, Jack in the Bot sailed cleanly through the elimination matches to take home the event win, as well as a judged Autonomous Award, presented for excellent automate play and scoring in the first 15 seconds of match play. **Congratulations!**
