

Registration Information for Online HS Classes

STUDENTS CURRENTLY ATTENDING EVERETT PUBLIC SCHOOLS

Registration for online HS tuition-based classes can be done at the Everett Public Schools website: www.everettsd.org/summerschool **Registration is available March 16th.**

You must have a valid email account prior to registering for classes.

Tuition Payment is Required at Time of Registration

All students who register for a class are required to pay at the time of registration. Payments can be made either online with a credit card, or by cash or check (made payable to Everett Public Schools) through your high school treasurer.

Tuition Assistance (for Everett Public Schools students only)

Information about **LIMITED** tuition assistance is available through your high school success coordinator or counselor. Priority will be given to students who are credit deficient and have signed up for free or reduced lunch prior to May 1, 2020.

Tuition for online HS in-district students is \$325.00 for each 0.5 credit class (one semester).

Final registration deadline: June 19, 2020.

After June 19, you will be put on a wait list.

STUDENTS WHO DO NOT ATTEND EVERETT PUBLIC SCHOOLS

Students living within the Everett Public Schools district boundary who **do not** attend Everett Public Schools OR students who are living outside the Everett Public Schools district who wish to attend online summer school **must** complete the online registration packet. Once complete, notify the summer school office at summerschool@everettsd.org. Your student will receive a district ID number and be able to register online for summer courses. Please contact the summer school office at 425-385-5170 or summerschool@everettsd.org with any questions.

Tuition Payment is Required Prior to Beginning Class

All students who register for a class are required to pay in full prior to the start of summer school. Payment instructions will be provided once you have completed registration.

Tuition for non-Everett Public Schools students in good standing at their regular school is \$425.00 per 0.5 credit class (one semester).

Final registration deadline: June 19, 2020.

After June 19, you will be put on a wait list.

For **ALL** students in a class that is cancelled due to low enrollment or who withdraw from a course **prior to July 6, 2020**, you will receive a full refund.

Students may take only one online class (one semester) at a time during the summer. PE 1 is the only class that can be taken concurrently with another class.

To be eligible to enroll in a second summer school online class, you must earn a passing grade in the first class prior to Friday, July 10. This allows time to complete the second course before the end of the summer semester on August 6.

Tuition for the second course is due at the time you enroll in the second class. The fee for a second class will be the same rate paid for the first class during initial enrollment.

Credit Recovery classes are designed to provide the student with an opportunity to learn content not picked up during the regular school year. Once the student has completed the required course work and demonstrated proficiency in the subject, they will be granted a passing grade.
