- Register for our Google Classroom entitled 'AP Capstone: Research' by signing in through the Everett Public Schools with your regular student/district login, click 'Classroom', click '+' (in the upper right-hand corner), click 'join class', and enter the course code: dqf7ov.
- Download and print the summer assignment by downloading
 it from the folder entitled 'Summer Assignment' that is found in
 our Google Classroom. Read pages 1 22 from the book *Practical Research: Planning and Design, 10e*. This is necessary to complete
 the summer assignment.
- Complete and upload your summer assignment to our Google Classroom by the first day of school – Wednesday, September 7, 2016.
- 4. Familiarize yourself with the course syllabus (Available August 2016)
- 5. Download the parent/student contract, read, sign, and bring to the first day of class.
- 6. Become familiar with the class calendar. Your weekly schedule is found here and all assignments.
- 7. Complete the student information survey found in week 1 on the calendar website
