1. Title of Book
2. Total number of pages of the book
3. Protagonist:
  - a. Proof that shows how the Protagonist transforms through the Denouement with page numbers and quotes
4. Antagonist:
  - a. Proof that shows how the Antagonist tries to influence or impede the Protagonist through the Climax with page numbers and quotes
5. Core of the Conflict:
  - a. Proof of what is at the heart of the battle between the protagonist and the antagonist with page numbers
6. Major Events that lead to Climax
  - a. Major Events that align with the Core of the Conflict that lead to the Climax with page numbers and quotes
7. Climax:
  - a. Final Event that aligns with Major Events and the Core of the Conflict between the Protagonist and the Antagonist with page numbers and quotes
8. Denouement or no Denouement:
  - a. Event that aligns with the Climax and resolves the Core of the Conflict between the Protagonist and the Antagonist

OR

  - b. In modern novels, there may be no clear resolution. You need to show how this works with your book
