

## Book Talk Journal Format

1. Title of Book
2. Total number of pages of the book
3. Protagonist: the person that is changed by the events of the book
  - a. Three examples that show how the Protagonist transforms through the Denouement with page numbers and quotes
4. Antagonist: the person that tries to stop the protagonist from reaching their goal; they aren't changed by the events in the book
  - a. Three examples that show how the Antagonist tries to influence or impede the Protagonist through the Climax with page numbers and quotes
5. Core of the Conflict:
  - a. Proof of what is at the heart of the battle between the protagonist and the antagonist with page numbers
6. Major Events that lead to Climax
  - a. 3 Major Events that align with the Core of the Conflict that lead to the Climax with page numbers and quotes
7. Climax:
  - a. Final Event that aligns with Major Events and the Core of the Conflict between the Protagonist and the Antagonist with page numbers and quotes
8. Denouement or no Denouement:
  - a. Event that aligns with the Climax and resolves the Core of the Conflict between the Protagonist and the Antagonist  
OR
  - b. In modern novels, there may be no clear resolution. You need to show how this works with your book
9. 30 Vocabulary Words from the book with definitions that match the context as well as the page number where the word was found
